- 100% of students achieved a grade at A level
- 77% of students achieved grades of C or above
- an outstanding 26% of students achieved the top grades of an A* or an A

For the second year running improved A-level and AS level results have built on the excellent foundations laid by staff and students at the popular, heavily oversubscribed school in Coldharbour Lane. Students will be celebrating some outstanding successes, marking the culmination of a year of excellent academic and personal achievements for students at the school, with an overall pass rate of 100%.

Newly appointed to the school in September 2014, Executive Principal Jeremy Turner said:

"We are really thrilled and delighted with the outstanding success of our students' A Levels results again this year. So many of them have achieved their expected places at some of the country's top universities and the headline figures demonstrate that the school is continuing to provide a high quality education to students in the local area.
